



Catalan Soccer - Medical Policy

Catalan Soccer may be responsible for your child's welfare during their time at Camps or weekly classes. This medical policy outlines our responsibilities as a childcare provider and serves as a reference for parents who may have concerns about their child being injured or needing medical attention because of ill-health during participation.

- We will not apply chemicals or plasters to your child's skin
- We may need to de-cloth to apply pressure to stem bleeding wounds until qualified medical personnel arrive
- We may need to administer basic first aid techniques to clear airways and assist your child in breathing
- We may need to administer CPR to help prolong circulation and oxygen supply until qualified medical personnel arrive
- We will not attempt to remove objects that may have become lodged in a child's body
- We will attempt to contact parents before any action that may compromise their child's right to personal privacy or religious belief
- We will only act in accordance with relevant emergency and first aid training
- We will not allow non-first aid trained personnel to carry out any emergency care on your child

By agreeing to this Medical Policy you are agreeing to your child receiving first-aid from trained members of our coaching team, and also for emergency medical professionals to carry out varying degrees of care in line with their professional assessment of your child's emergency needs.
